


Targeted Network Expansion

Schemes may not have coverage of adequately skilled providers in all the geographic areas in which they have members. Schemes therefore seek to expand their networks to include providers with specific skills(e.g. in diabetes or HIV), to ensure these skills are available in areas with high member density for those conditions.

Solution Description

Schemes can use EMGuidance's country-wide digital healthcare platform to source and onboard more GPs and specialists onto the network. Sourcing can be done according to location (up to suburb level), age, qualifications and specific clinical skills. Positive responses are directed to the scheme portal for registration and tariff arrangements.
