


1. Screening and Prevention Solutions

Overview

Chronic diseases are the largest drivers of costs. Early diagnosis remains the best approach to reducing downstream claims. Surveys indicate that providers would like to do more screening but are unaware of screening benefits and not up to speed with clinical rules for screening.

A small number of high-risk patients are responsible for disproportionate claims and require enhanced screening efforts.

EMGuidance's screening modules are designed to work synergistically to enhance provider screening activity overall, with a specific focus on high-risk patients.







Module 2

General Screening Reminders

General clinical reminder messages and notices are developed to address a screening-behaviour objective. These may be sent to all network providers, to providers in specific locations or to providers who see relevant high-risk populations, e.g. reminders to do HbA1Cs screenings on diabetic patients.

Screening Decision Tool

Upload all your screening, care plan and managed care screening and testing rules, onto EMGuidance's comprehensive standard screening tool.
